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New Businesses Moving into Snoqualmie Ridge Business Park

Snoqualmie, WA – Several new businesses are making their homes in the Snoqualmie Ridge Business Park, bringing nearly 600 jobs to support the local economy.

[Motion Water Sports](#), a leader in the manufacturing and distribution of water sport products, will be relocating its headquarters from Redmond to a building currently under construction at 7926 Bracken Place SE. The move in date for the company's 85 employees is scheduled for early December. The facility will have 18,000 square feet of office space and 117,000 square feet for a main distribution center for HO, Liquid Force, Connelly/CWB, and two other affiliated water sports brands.

"When we came across the property at Snoqualmie Ridge, we realized what a perfect opportunity it was to build from the ground up," said John Archer, President of Motion Water Sports. "Not only was the decision made from an economic point of view, but we fell in love with the city and its beautiful surroundings."

[Spacelabs Healthcare](#) will relocate its corporate headquarters from Issaquah to Snoqualmie in early 2013. It will occupy 176,000 square feet in the former Philips Oral Healthcare building at 35301 SE Center St. Spacelabs Healthcare will bring 400 jobs in manufacturing, research and development, and marketing. The company manufactures and distributes advanced medical care equipment including patient monitors, anesthesia systems and ventilators, products for use in diagnostic cardiology, and other products and services.

The [King County Department of Permitting and Environmental Review](#) relocated its offices from Renton to Snoqualmie in mid-October. This King County department has approximately 90 employees and occupies 29,000 square feet in the Kendall Lake Building at 35030 SE Douglas St. The department issues building and land use permits for properties located in unincorporated King County, enforces county land use and building codes, and staffs the King County Fire Marshal Division.

"We're very excited about having nearly 600 new jobs coming to the Snoqualmie Valley," said Kevin Dwyer, CEO of the Snoqualmie Valley Chamber of Commerce. "These companies will enrich our communities and will have positive, far-reaching impacts on our restaurants, shops, housing, and small businesses. We look forward to welcoming them here and hope that their presence will help us attract similar businesses that appreciate our friendly business climate, proximity to Seattle, Bellevue and Tacoma, our natural beauty and laid back lifestyle."
