The Snoqualmie Sister Cities Association is seeking home stays for three girls and six boys arriving August 4 and departing August 20 (16 days). Ideal homes would be those with children in middle or high school. Home school families are also welcome to apply!

A \$500 stipend per teen is available for host families to offset costs of meals and activities. A stipend of \$1,100 is available for families that take two travelers. All exchange students will have traveler's insurance and personal spending money.

Snoqualmie Sister Cities Association board members will coordinate and chaperone weekday activities such as local tours, a day in Olympia, hiking, local festivals, and other fun! Host family kids are welcome to come along. Families will have their guests on weekday evenings, weekends, and for summer getaways.
