CHECK POSITION (S) OF INTEREST:

_____ **ARTS COMMISSION: 4 YEAR TERM / 9 MEMBERS**

Promotes and encourages public programs to further the development and public awareness of and interest in the fine and performing arts, and preservation of the cultural heritage of Snoqualmie.

_____ **CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION: 6 YEAR TERM / 5 MEMBERS**

3-YEAR RESIDENCY REQUIRED. Establishes hiring policy and hiring list for law enforcement and fire department employees. Hears appeals of disciplinary actions.

_____ **PLANNING COMMISSION: 6 YEAR TERM/9 MEMBERS**

RESIDENCY within the City is required. Recommends Policy and acts as quasi-judicial body on land use, planning and development issues. Meets 1st and 3rd Mondays of each month and as needed.

_____ **PARK AND EVENTS COMMISSION: 4 YEAR TERM/9 MEMBERS**

Recommends policy regarding City Parks. Reviews parks plans. Advise the City concerning recreation and cultural events and programs. Meets 3rd Monday of each month or as needed.

_____ **SHORELINE HEARING BOARD: 4 YEAR TERM / 6 MEMBERS**

Members are appointed by the Mayor, of which four are citizens and two are staff members. Established to review Shoreline Conditional Permits and update the Shoreline Master Program.

_____ **MAYORS HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE:**

Review applications for Human Services Funds and make recommendations to the Council Committee.

_____ **LOGGING TAX ADVISORY COMMITTEE (LTAC):**

The purpose of the LTAC is to perform the functions of a lodging tax advisory committee under RCW 67.28.1817 and serve in an advisory capacity to the City Council. The Lodging Tax Advisory Committee shall consist of at least five members. The Committee membership shall be in accordance with RCW 67.28.1817 and include a) at least two members who are representatives of businesses required to collect tax; and b) at least two members who are persons involved in activities authorized to be funded by revenue received from the Hotel-Motel Tax and c) one member who shall be an elected official who shall serve as chair of the committee. Persons eligible for appointment as representatives of businesses required to collect taxes shall not also be eligible for appointment as persons involved in activities authorized to be funded by revenue received from the Hotel-Motel Tax.

_____ **ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION:**

The Economic Development Commission shall consist of nine members, who shall reside within the city and/or own or operate a business within the Snoqualmie business community and shall serve two year terms. The Economic Development Commission shall have the following duties: A. to hold regular public meetings. B. To prepare an Economic Development Element for the Snoqualmie Vicinity Comprehensive Plan in accordance with section 2.22.080, and from time to time to recommend amendments thereto. C. To make periodic recommendations to Planning Commission and City Council regarding the impact on economic development of the plans, policies and regulations of the City and D. To provide such other advice and recommendations to the Mayor and City Council regarding matters affecting economic development within the city as may be requested by mayor or city council.
