Potential Annexation Could Lead to Adult Living Community ***Public Meetings: July 24, July 31, and August 14 at 7 p.m., City Hall***

Snoqualmie, WA – A portion of Snoqualmie Hills West, which is in the City of Snoqualmie Urban Growth Area (UGA), is under consideration for annexation. (A map is on the City of Snoqualmie website at bit.ly/SHPAnnexation.)

Snoqualmie Heights Partners submitted a noticed of intention to petition for annexation to the City of Snoqualmie. If the potential annexation moves forward, Snoqualmie Heights Partners has indicated it may propose development of a master-planned active adult community for those age 55 and older, however, at this time, no actual proposal for development has been filed with the City.

In preparation for Snoqualmie City Council consideration of the annexation in mid-August, there will be three opportunities for public comment.

At the City Council meeting on July 24, there will be a presentation by the developer followed by opportunity for public comment. A special City Council meeting will be held on July 31 to allow ample time for public comment, which will be further continued at the City Council meeting on August 14. Presentations and comment periods will begin each of the three evenings at 7 p.m. or soon thereafter.
