Mayor Larson Re-elected; Voters Elect Four New Council Members

Snoqualmie, WA – The King County November 2017 general election results have been certified.

Matthew R. Larson has been re-elected as Mayor of Snoqualmie and will begin his fourth term on January 1, 2018. He has also served the Snoqualmie community as Mayor Pro-Tem, City Council Member, Planning Commission Chair, and Parks Board Member. He will be sworn into office at the January 8, 2018 City Council meeting.

Four new City Council Members have been elected by Snoqualmie voters. Two Council Members have been elected to retain their positions and one remains in office under appointment.

Position 1

Council Member Bob Jeans has retained Position 1, which he has held since 2006. His term will expire December 31, 2021. He will be sworn into office at the January 8, 2018 City Council meeting.

Position 2

Council Member Katherine Ross was originally appointed to Position 2 following the resignation of Chelley Patterson. Ross retains that position following the results of the general election. Her term begins immediately and will expire on December 31, 2019. She will be sworn into office at the January 8, 2018 City Council meeting.

Position 3

Council Member Bryan Holloway has retained Position 3, which he has held for three terms. His term will expire December 31, 2021. He will be sworn into office at the January 8, 2018 City Council meeting.

Position 4

This position was the only one not on the ballot. Council Member James Mayhew was appointed to Position 4 in October following the resignation of Brad Toft. Mayhew will serve through December 31, 2019. Although appointed to this position, he will have the option of running for office in the 2019 general election.

Position 5

Matt Laase has been elected to serve in Position 5 with a term beginning January 1, 2018 and expiring December 31, 2021. He will be sworn into office at the January 8, 2018 City Council meeting. This position is currently held by Council Member Heather Munden, who has served since January 2014.

Position 6

Council Member Sean Sundwall was originally appointed to Position 6 following the passing of Council Member Charles Peterson. Sundwall retains that position. His term begins immediately and will expire on December 31, 2019. He will be sworn into office at the January 8, 2018 City Council meeting.

Position 7

Peggy Shepard has been elected to serve in Position 7. Her term begins January 1, 2018 and will expire December 31, 2021. She will be sworn into office at the January 8, 2018 City Council meeting. This position is currently held by Council Member Kathi Prewitt who has served since September 2004.
