A Resolution of the Snoqualmie Valley School District #410 (SVSD) Declaring Its Support for the City of Snoqualmie's November 4, 2008 Bond Referendum to Construct a Community Center and Pool Facilities

WHEREAS, the City of Snoqualmie and the Snoqualmie Valley School District (SVSD) have agreed to partner and support one another in our respective mission and business operations around initiatives that will expand local educational and enrichment programs for youth, families and the greater Snoqualmie Valley community while preserving our fiscal stewardship of public funds, and

WHEREAS, the City of Snoqualmie community center/YMCA would provide such opportunity to enhance the quality of life through facilities and programs for before/after school care, educational and recreational enrichment for the citizens of Snoqualmie Valley, and

WHEREAS, one such envisioned partnership between the City of Snoqualmie and the SVSD might focus on the development of a youth water safety program to ensure that all youth learn to swim and to appreciate and respect the rivers and lakes in our valley, and

WHEREAS, the YMCA already has a 20+ year history of partnering with the SVSD to provide enrichment and before/after school care programs for the residents of the Snoqualmie Valley, and

WHEREAS, the current SVSD #410 facilities are struggling to keep up with current and growing space demands for the YMCA's before/after school care programs, and


WHEREAS, the City of Snoqualmie is committed to assisting the SVSD in addressing these facility and program needs, and

WHEREAS, the City of Snoqualmie and the SVSD have already enjoyed successful partnerships surrounding an agreement for shared vehicle and equipment maintenance operations and shared storage space on City property for the SVSD bus barn so as to preserve the location of the soccer field adjacent to the SVSD district offices in downtown Snoqualmie and assisting with school district space needs by leasing the old library building to the SVSD,



Passed by the Snoqualmie Valley School District #410 Board of Directors this 25th day of September, 2008.




